SECTION 12357 - KITCHEN CASEWORK

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 SUMMARY

A. Summary of Work:

1. Provide prefabricated modular kitchen casework.

1.2 SUBMITTALS

- A. Product Data: Submit manufacturer's product data and installation instructions for each material and product used.
- B. Shop Drawings: Submit shop drawings indicating material characteristics, details of construction, connections, and relationship with adjacent construction.
- C. Samples: Submit two representative samples of each material specified indicating visual characteristics and finish. Include range samples if variation of finish is anticipated.

1.3 QUALITY ASSURANCE

- A. Comply with governing codes and regulations. Provide products of acceptable manufacturers, which have been in satisfactory use in similar service for three years. Use experienced installers. Deliver, handle, and store materials in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.
- B. Standards: KCMA A161.11.

PART 2 - PRODUCTS

2.1 MATERIALS

- A. Manufacturers: Legacy Cabinets or Architect approved equivalent.
- B. Casework:
 1. Materials: Solid cherry or maple wood.
 2. Face Style: Reveal overlay.
 3. Frame Fabrication: Face frame.
 4. Finish: Stain, sealer coat, and polyurethane topcoat.

5. Finish Application: Factory-finished.
6. Hardware: Contemporary style.

C. Countertops:

1. Materials: 3 cm granite stone with plywood substrate.
2. Front Profile: Beveled.
3. Backsplash: Applied 3 cm granite stone, square profile.

D. Accessories:

1. Undermounted sink.

PART 3 - EXECUTION

3.1 INSTALLATION

- A. Install materials and systems in accordance with manufacturer's instructions and approved submittals. Install materials and systems in proper relation with adjacent construction and with uniform appearance. Coordinate with work of other sections.
- B. Restore damaged finishes and test for proper operation. Clean and protect work from damage.
